
EU: 28 countries, 511 mil persons








EFTA institutions – mirror of EU's



Local adaption

Needed:

 1 act of incoperation (GDPR)

• Change 99 act

Done:

 No acts of incoperation (GDPR)

 No proposals, no acts changed

Will Norway make 25 May?

Department of Justice says:

- Notified Parliament of proposal in April
- «a certain uncertainty» if will make 25 May
 - need incorporation EEA Agreement
 - depends mostly on EU

3 March 2018



What if we don't make it?

Department of Justice says:

- Will not affect flow of data
- 1995 directive will apply

GDPR art. 94 state:

- "1. Directive 95/46/EC is repealed with effect from 25 May 2018.
- 2. References to the repealed Directive shall be construed as references to this Regulation. [...]"

Types of changes in Norway

- 1. «Easy of use» changes
- 2. Supplements
- 3. Harmonisation

Examples

- Age limit for Facebook etc. (13 years)
- Sensitive data for research and statistics
- Prior consultation
- Licensing system ends
- Video surveillance

Business readiness Norway

- An early majority is aware
- A minority has started
- Few will be near compliant 25 May
