

Sub Sahara Africa (SSA) growth opportunity





Real GDP growth





Urban population (% of total population)





39 out of the 54 African countries have established cyber security legislation, while 2 have draft legislation under development


The adoption of cyber security policies and regulations across Africa stands at 72 %, which is the lowest across the globe

Nation state legislation and themes

- The number of AI legislations continues to grow in *double digits from the 9 reported in 2019*
- **Economics and public finance** leads the category on the AI related bills - **29**
- This is closely followed by **science technology and communication** - **11 bills**
- **National security** follows through in the third place with **7 bills**
- **Top themes** around the bills include – 1) Legal acts 2) International agreements 3) Legislative procedures 4) Cybersecurity 5) Public disclosures
